Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

One way to share your concern for others in your parish family is by joining the Prayer Line. It is a special and quiet ministry established in January 1993. A volunteer who joins the Prayer Line does not have to be eloquent in prayer. A willing heart is all God desires. No certain prayers are required. Lifting your heart and mind to God in concern for other's request is all that is needed.

The prayer line consists of the primary caller, who receives all requests, and passes them to the volunteers. Carol Zabielski (860-643-2837) is the primary caller.

As a volunteer, you will be asked to join a telephone or an email line. In a telephone line, you will receive a prayer request from a member of your line after which you will pass the request on to the next person in your line. In the email line, you will simply receive an email with the request from Rich Carpenter, the coordinator of the email line.

Prayer requests will include a first name and frequently a brief reason for the request (cancer, death, family crises, etc.). Sometimes, only a name will be given. All information shared must be kept confidential.

Please consider becoming a member. Again, all God wants is a willing heart. What wonderful gifts we can share through prayer.
