## ELEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

2 Sm 12:7–10, 13 / Gal 2:16, 19–21  
Lk 7:36—8:3 or 7:36–50

David is a hero to his people. He is the warrior who pushed back enemies by the thousands. David is also a poet—we still follow him in worship, praying his psalms. This amazing leader united the tribes of Israel into one kingdom. And God had even greater plans in mind for him.

This same David had Uriah killed. It would be hard to imagine anyone more loyal to his king than this victim. David coveted and then stole Uriah's wife, Bathsheba. The prophet Nathan stood in front of David and exposed before him the depth of treachery to which he had sunk. Who are you, David? You are that man, the one who deserves death.


Could we imagine a stronger rebuke than Nathan's to David: "Why have you spurned the LORD and done evil in his sight?"

David fell deep into sin from his higher place. David's story sinks into our stomachs with sickening recognition. It's embarrassing to look at this man David. In each of us is a place where we know our own sin: Have I betrayed someone who trusted me? Have I hidden from what I promised? We understand David if we've ever struggled—if we've struggled even to admit what we've done.

And here is the amazing reality—this situation, this recognition, this depth is where God reaches into us to forgive. How deep is the problem? God's forgiveness is deeper. God's presence is deeper than the most treacherous sin. God forgives. When we're shaken most deeply by realizing how far we've moved away from God, God comes to us.

David's sorrow and repentance are all he had left. Though he suffered greatly because he sinned, still God saved him.

**SIGN AND SYMBOL:** This solemnity begs several questions: How well does the parish follow the Lord’s command to “take and drink”? How well does the parish do its entire Communion rite? The General Instruction of the Roman Missal, 85, says that the faithful should “receive the Lord’s Body from hosts consecrated at the same Mass.” Some have noted that we have developed a “refrigerator mentality” at Sunday worship. The tabernacle, like a refrigerator, is seen as the place where we immediately turn to retrieve the leftovers from a previous meal. The Church is insistent that the tabernacle is used to reserve the Eucharistic bread for the sick and the dying, and for Eucharistic devotion. The Church is clear that we should be receiving the bread and wine consecrated at the Mass at which we celebrate. Turning to the tabernacle should only be done as a last resort, when all of the Eucharistic bread consecrated at the given Mass has been consumed. Many parishes have figured out ways to anticipate the number of people receiving Eucharist at each parish Mass and the amount of bread is set out accordingly.

**THE OFFICE OF FAMILY LIFE** offers programs designed to enrich Family Life and Living. An ideal way to introduce the future husband and wife to the beauty of the Church’s vision of marriage, as proclaimed by Pope John Paul II writings of “The Theology of the Body.” And for those who are silently grieving over a past abortion, there is Rachel’s Vineyard Retreat. Most people are unaware of the emotional impact a past abortion can have on a person. New Love – New Life Remarriage program offers emotional and spiritual support to those contemplating a remarriage commitment and to those already living that unique experience. Natural Family Planning is a program dedicated to both those to be married as well as those who are already married and of child bearing age.
