dear **Padre** Can a church have two tabernacies²

My pastor recently moved the Blessed Sacrament to our new adoration chapel. Mass just isn't the same without the tabernacle in plain sight. Is there some reason we can't move the tabernacle to the main sanctuary for Mass, or even have two tabernacles?

Dear Dianna.

This is a very important matter, because the Mass and the Blessed Sacrament lie at the very heart and practice of our Catholic faith.

According to paragraph 72 of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops' 2000 publication Built of Living Stones: Art, Architecture, and Worship, only one tabernacle is allowed per church. It must be fixed and secure, not movable. It may be placed centrally in the church or located to the side, but it cannot be placed on the altar.

Your parish's adoration chapel is a fitting location for the tabernacle. At Mass you are busy and active—listening, standing, kneeling, sitting, praying, singing. Kneeling before the tabernacle in your adoration chapel, you are mainly quiet: praying, gazing, contemplating.

The Eucharist is both sacrament and sacrificepassion, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ, and also his real and abiding Presence. We need both tabernacle and altar to celebrate the full mystery of the Eucharist.
