# Good News!

December 5, 2010

#### SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT

Is 11:1–10 / Rom 15:4–9 / Mt 3:1–12

We've all had this experience: At a party we're introduced to someone, and that person warmly greets us with, "Oh, I've heard so much about you!" Often there's some polite teasing— "Gosh, I hope it was all good things!"—and laughter ensues. It's a light way to ease into conversation.

While it's most likely that the person has heard all good things, this experience always makes me wonder, What has she heard about me? How have I been described? What has gone before me to someone else's ears? For while there are many aspects of myself I would be pleased were shared, a shudder runs down my spine when I think of other, less-glowing elements of my personality that may have preceded me. There are some past behaviors and persistent traits that I would dread having someone know about before meeting me.

Today's Scripture readings are full of great expectations people had of Jesus before he was born. We look back at Isaiah's prophecies of a future king and see the promise of Jesus-a peacemaker, one who would bring justice to the poor and the afflicted. John the Baptist preaches about one who will baptize with fire and the Holy Spirit—Jesus, who seeks repentance and conversion of

We may not normally think about Advent as a time of repentance, but in fact it's an excellent time to reflect on aspects of ourselves that we shudder to think someone has "heard so much about." Our tendency toward selfishness, our lack of generosity, our rigid stubbornnesswhere do we need to seek repentance so we might better welcome Jesus, the one so much was said about, the one we hope to model our lives after?
