PENTECOST SUNDAY

Acts 2:1–11 / 1 Cor 12:3b–7, 12–13 Jn 20:19–23

Pentecost is God's biggest surprise party. Jesus' disciples and Jews from distant nations had traveled to Jerusalem to observe the agricultural feast of Pentecost, marking the end of the grain harvest.

They thought they were fulfilling their normal religious observations. But then, with rushing wind and tongues of fire, God hollered "Surprise!" and filled the disciples with the Holy Spirit. They had gathered for religious observance, but God had gathered them for a celebration.

Pentecost truly serves as the surprise birthday party for the Church—the day the Church was born in the power of the Spirit. The visiting Jews were able to understand the disciples in their native languages because God's gift of the Holy Spirit unified strangers.

In 1 Corinthians, Paul highlights the Spirit's unifying nature. Our Church is one body, filled with one Spirit, created by one Lord. Though each of us is blessed with different gifts and born into different circumstances, we are knit into one body by the Spirit.

Yet we know well how religion has been used to divide nations, peoples, and families. As Christians, we ought to feel deeply saddened at the times our faith and many other faiths have abandoned the uniting power of the Spirit and fostered discord, violence, and intolerance.

But even the most divisive human actions cannot suppress the Spirit's power. The tongues of fire cannot be quenched. The rushing wind of God will not be slowed. Every time we extend a hand of welcome, every time we reconcile with another, every time we seek to bring people together, we open our hearts to the Spirit's movement. It's our surprise gift back to God in gratitude for the precious gift of the Holy Spirit.

Pentecost Meditation:

Thirst and the Holy Spirit......The ultimate thirst of men cries out for the Holy Spirit. He, and he alone, is, at a profound level, the fresh water without which there is no life. In the image of a spring, of the water that irrigates and transforms a desert, that man meets like a secret promise, the mystery of the Spirit becomes visible in an ineffable fashion that no rational meditation can encompass. In man's thirst, and in his being refreshed by water. is portrayed that infinite, far more radical thirst that can be guenched by no other water....The Holy Spirit is eternally, of his very nature, God's gift, God as wholly self giving, God as sharing himself, as gift. In that sense, the inner reason and basis for creation and salvation history do after all lie in this quality of being of the Holy Spirit, as donum and datum... He is the content of Christian prayer. He is the only gift worthy of God; as God. God gives nothing other than God; he gives himself and thereby everything. That is why properly Christian prayer, again, does not beg for just anything; rather, it begs for the gift of God that is God himself, begs for him.
