dear Padre **How long is Jesus** present in the host?

I was taught that Jesus is present in the consecrated host only for about fifteen minutes. Is that true?

Dear Alfred,

No. Our Church teaches that by the words of Christ and the invocation of the Holy Spirit, the bread and wine offered at Mass become Christ's Body and Blood (Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1333). Classically, we use the language of transubstantiation to describe this change: While the sensed characteristics like taste, smell, and feel of the bread and wine remain the same, their substance or essence changes through God's grace so that they really are the Body and Blood of Christ. Christ is present within them body, blood, soul, and divinity and no time limit is associated with this Real Presence.

We keep the Blessed Sacrament reserved in our tabernacles (the locked boxes where the priest places uneaten consecrated hosts after Communion) because we believe in this ongoing presence of Christ, and we want to show adequate reverence for the Lord's sacramental presence in our midst. The abiding presence of Christ in the consecrated hosts allows us to carry the Blessed Sacrament to the sick and the homebound long after the celebration of Mass.

The presence of Christ in the Blessed Sacrament also provides us with a focal point for our prayer and understanding of Christ's abiding presence whenever we walk into or pass by a church where the Blessed Sacrament is reserved.




