July 3, 2011 dear Padre **Who supports priests** and religious in retirement?

I always thought the Church supports priests and religious in retirement, but our parish priest recently spoke of saving for his retirement. Why doesn't the Church take care of them?

Dear Raymond,

Your parish priest is clearly a diocesan priest. He belongs to a group of priests serving under the bishop of the (arch) diocese. He is paid a salary, and he must plan for and pay into a fund for his own retirement.

Other priests belong to religious orders like the Redemptorists, Jesuits, or Franciscans. If they receive a salary or payment for services, they don't bank it for themselves- they give it to the community. In turn, the community cares for them when they get sick or grow old.

Religious sisters or nuns operate like these priests, belonging to communities like the Sisters of Mercy or the Sisters of Saint Joseph. These nuns have grown much fewer and much older. The communities they counted on to care for them in their old age have often become impoverished and greatly burdened by the number of aging sisters.

The National Religious Retirement Office raises funds to help religious orders support their elderly members. The individual orders also welcome donations for that purpose.


