## November 20, 2011 Blessed Sacrament

What is the difference between Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament and Exposition of the Eucharist?

#### Dear Marcella.

Exposition and Benediction are the beginning and ending rituals of eucharistic adoration. In Exposition, the Blessed Sacrament is placed in a monstrance for public adoration. In Benediction, the priest or deacon blesses the assembly with the consecrated host.

Designated laypersons can do the Exposition of the Eucharist, but Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament can be performed only by a priest or deacon. A layperson may return the Eucharist to the tabernacle after adoration.

Adoration of the Eucharist displayed in a monstrance or simply locked in a tabernacle became an important devotion during the Middle Ages. In modern times, it has increased in popularity at the encouragement of Pope John Paul II. Parishes throughout the United States have perpetualadoration societies and chapels where the Fucharist is exposed 24 hours a day.

The devotion of adoration of the Eucharist can be a time of great stillness for those who practice it. It is never to be a substitute for the celebration of the Eucharist or the reception of holy Communion, but adoration as a form of prayer, meditation, and contemplation is a valuable source of openness to Christ, who speaks to us in the silence.
