February 24, 2013 Can people with dementia make a valid confession?

My husband has vascular dementia and isn't able to make an examination of conscience. Since part of the anointing of the sick involves confession of sins, will it be valid when he receives it?

If circumstances permit, the sacrament of anointing of the sick may be preceded by the sacrament of penance and followed by the sacrament of the Eucharist (Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1517).

However, when conditions such as your husband's don't allow this, judgment on the suitability for anointing is to be made prudently and without scruple (Pastoral Care of the Sick, 8). For example, anointing is conferred on people who have lost consciousness or the use of reason if as Christian believers they would have "at least implicitly asked for it when they were in control of their faculties" (PCS 14). Therefore, because of the degree of brainfunction loss in this circumstance, the sacrament of anointing also absolves any sins.

When a habitual desire to die as a faithful Catholic is implied before a person's illness, the special grace of the sacrament of anointing has this as one of its effects: "the forgiveness of sins, if the sick person was not able to obtain it through the sacrament of Penance" (CCC 1532).
