

When Should I File a Sexual Abuse Claim?

Regardless of how old you are today or when the sexual abuse occurred, you need to file your claim so that it is received by 5 p.m. (prevailing Eastern Time) on March 15, 2022.

If you do not file a funcly Sexual Abuse Claim, you may lose rights against the Dioxese and against Dacese Rolated Entities, including any right in compensation.




