

#### GOSPEL MEDITATION

It's common for Catholics to hear the question, "Why do I have to go to a priest to have my sins forgiven?" I've never liked that question because not only is it clunky (confession is the ordinary way for the pardoning of serious sins, not lesser ones). But it misses the larger context: the wonderful origins of the sacrament itself. And this context is deeply Jewish.

Ancient Jews associated forgiveness of sins with priests offering sacrifices in the Jerusalem temple. It was a solemn, public, and tangible way to access God's mercy. So when the risen Jesus breathes on the Apostles and says, "Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained" (John 20:23), the upshot is remarkable: he is the new temple and his Apostles are the new priests. Jerusalem is no longer the place to find forgiveness from sin. Jesus' body, the Church, is.

So why should we go to the Sacrament of Confession? For the same reason ancient Jews went to the temple in Jerusalem: to experience the intimacy, joy, and life-giving power of God's eternal forgiveness.

#### Diocese of Norwich Mourns the Death of Pope Francis Memorial Masses to Be Celebrated in Hartford and Worcester

NORWICH, CT — With deep sorrow and profound respect, the Diocese of Norwich joins Catholics around the world in mourning the death of Pope Francis, who passed away at 7:35 a.m. local time on Easter Monday, April 21, at his residence in the Vatican's Casa Santa Marta, as confirmed by the Holy See Press Office. The 88-year-old pontiff led the Catholic Church for more than 12 years, dedicating his life to Christ and to the service of the Church with humility, compassion, and courage.

The Most Reverend Christopher J. Coyne, Archbishop of Hartford and Apostolic Administrator of Norwich, issued the following statement:

#### Statement of the Most Reverend Christopher J. Coyne

I join with Bishop-elect Richard Reidy and the entire community of the Diocese of Norwich in offering prayers for the repose of the soul of Pope Francis. May he rest in peace.

As Archbishop of Hartford and Apostolic Administrator of Norwich, I will celebrate a Memorial Mass for Pope Francis at 12:10 PM today at the metropolitan Cathedral of St. Joseph in Hartford. Bishop-elect Reidy will concelebrate a Memorial Mass with Bishop Robert McManus today at 12:10 at the Cathedral of St. Paul in Worcester, MA.

Pope Francis, born Jorge Mario Bergoglio on December 17, 1936, in Buenos Aires, Argentina, was the first pope from Latin America and the first Jesuit to serve as pontiff. Throughout his papacy, he was a tireless advocate for the poor, a voice for peace, and a beacon of hope and mercy in an often divided world.

Further details regarding funeral arrangements in Rome and diocesan memorial observances will be shared as they become available.
