Go Green: Minimize Packaging- Look for loose fruit and vegetables, and take your own containers to shops and markets. Buy products from the "bins" that you can store in resealable bags or containers at home. If you are buying packaged food, look at where the product comes from and try to choose the more local option – oat milk from New England will have a lower carbon footprint than almond milk from California, even if they have the same packaging.
