- 2. Classes are being held on Sunday mornings for your convenience to attend the 7:30 or 10:00 am mass; however, your family may choose to attend the Saturday Vigil mass. In addition, students in the Faith Formation program are recommended to attend mass on Holy Days of Obligation. Youth masses are generally held once a month at the 10:00 am mass. All children are invited to participate in some way.
- Parents are encouraged to stay for fellowship while their children are in classes, but if you leave please return by 9:45 as many catechists attend the 10:00 am mass.
- 4. It is important students have good attendance which includes being on time, especially given that class times are short.
- 5. Children in grades 1-8 will receive books. It is suggested children leave them in their classrooms so they will have them each week. If you want your child to bring their books home anytime just ask their teacher. Students will bring home their books at the end of the year.
- 6. Students are discouraged from bringing cell phones or electronic devices to class or on retreats as they can be a distraction, lost, or forgotten.
