



33 DAY CONSECRATION TO ST. JOSEPH

After this last reading, recite at least one decade of the Rosary and meditate on The Litany to St. Joseph. Excerpts taken from *Consecration to St. Joseph, The Wonders of Our Spiritual Father*, by Fr. Donald H. Calloway, MIC.

Day 33, Sun, Nov 1st, FEAST OF ALL SAINTS: He Made Him the Lord of His Household, and Prince Over All His Possessions. “As Almighty God appointed Joseph, son of the patriarch Jacob, over all the land of Egypt to save grain for the people, so when the fullness of time was come and he was about to send on earth his only-begotten Son, the Savior of the world, he chose another Joseph of whom the first had been a type, and he made him the lord and chief of his household and possessions, the guardian of his choicest treasures.” (Blessed Pope Pius IX)
