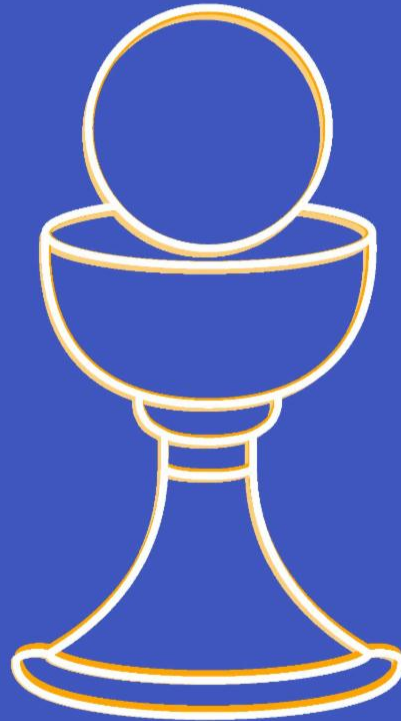




The Eucharistic Revival The Eucharist, did you know?

How do we recognize God's presence in the Old Testament?

The Bible reveals that God chooses to be with us so that we can be in the right relationship with God. The Old Testament describes several ways that God freely chooses to be present with us (local/temporal/personal) through something that is "sense perceptible" so we can experience it. For example, God appears to persons in dreams, to Moses in the burning bush, to the exodus community in the pillar of fire and cloud, to worshippers in the temple, to the prophets in God's word and to the people in social and personal situations.
